Subj: PHOTOGRAPHIC SECURITY

1. Purpose. To provide guidance and restrictions as to the control of photography (still or video) aboard Marine Corps Air Facility Quantico.

2. Cancellation. AFO 5510.2A.

3. Background. The references establish procedures for the control of photography (still or video) within the Marine Corps and the Department of the Navy.

4. Information

a. The Commanding Officer, Marine Corps Air Facility is responsible for controlling photography (still or video), official and unofficial, within his/her jurisdiction, regardless of whether the photographers are attached to the Department of the Navy, Marine Corps, or are private citizens. All requests to photograph any of the Marine Corps Air Facility will be routed via the Security Officer of HMX-1 for input prior to submission to the Commanding Officer, Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico or designated representative for approval consideration.


b. When an authority higher than the Commanding Officer authorizes taking official or unofficial photographs (still or video), the Commanding Officer is still responsible for supervision, sanitization, and release of resulting photographs (still or video), unless he/she is specifically relieved of that responsibility by the higher authority.

c. No military, civilian, or news media representatives are permitted to take official or unofficial photographs (still or video) of aircraft or aircraft operating areas without the specific authorization of the Commanding Officer, Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico or a designated representative.

5. Action

a. The Operations Officer, Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico, is hereby designated as a representative to review all requests for official and unofficial photographs (still or video) to be taken aboard the Air Facility. The Operations Officer will be guided in the performance of his/her duties by the guidance established in the references. If the request is approved, a qualified Marine will accompany the photographer to act in an advisory capacity to prevent unauthorized photographs from being taken.

b. All personnel are directed to be alert for unauthorized personnel taking photographs (still or video) aboard the Air Facility. Unauthorized personnel discovered to be violating criteria established by this order will be immediately brought to the attention of Marine Helicopter Squadron One Security personnel. The Operations Officer, Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico will be notified of any unauthorized photography conducted aboard the Air Facility.
