1. Purpose. To promulgate, in accordance with reference (a), motor vehicle and traffic regulations for Marine Corps Air Facility (MCAF), Quantico.

2. Cancellation. AFO 5560.1A.

3. Information

a. The operation of privately owned vehicles (POV's) aboard MCAF is a privilege extended to vehicle operators by the Commanding Officer, MCAF. This Order contains procedures required for personnel to exercise that privilege.

b. Reference (b) contains policy and procedure regarding search and seizure of vehicles operated aboard MCCDC, Quantico. Reference (c) publishes policy and procedure regarding security inspections and checkpoints.

c. Enclosures (1) through (3) provide motor vehicle operating and traffic regulations, amplifying instructions for registration of vehicles operated aboard the MCAF, and a detailed map of MCAF designated parking areas.

4. Action

a. Commanding Officer, Marine Helicopter Squadron One (HMX-1)

(1) Coordinate with the Provost Marshal Office (PMO) for the registration of POV's which will be operated aboard MCAF.


(2) Enforce the regulations contained in enclosures (1 and (2) and those applicable from reference (a).

b. Squadron Commanders and Department Heads. Give widest dissemination of the contents of this Order to all military and civilian personnel under their cognizance.

c. Motor Vehicle Operators. Comply with the provisions of enclosures (1) through (3).

5. Summary of Revision. This Order has been revised to correct minor format errors.

6. Applicability. This Order is applicable to all military and civilian personnel operating motor vehicles within the limits of MCAF, Quantico.

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MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

1. Admission of Privately-Owned Motor Vehicles

a. No motor vehicle will be permitted to enter MCAF unless it is properly registered with the HMX-1 Security Officer or PMO and displays a valid decal or other appropriate identification in accordance with reference (b) and as specified herein.

b. Trailers and other vehicles designed to be towed will be registered in accordance with reference (a).

c. Motor-driven vehicles such as trail bikes, all-terrain cycles and other such vehicles will be operated in accordance with reference (a).

2. Traffic Regulations

a. Motor Vehicle Laws. All motor vehicles aboard the MCAF, Quantico will be registered in accordance with the current laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and reference (a), and as further specified in this Order.

b. Speed Limits. The maximum authorized speeds are:

Bauer Road. Thirty-five miles per hour.

Rowell Road. Fifteen miles per hour.

(3) Cunningham Road (Airfield perimeter road). Twenty-five miles per hour.

(4) Unimproved Roads. Fifteen miles per hour.

c. Parking

(1) Parking of vehicles is permitted only in designated areas in accordance with the provisions of reference (a) and this Order.

Parking is prohibited in the following areas:

(a) On Rowell Road, except in those spaces designated in front of Building 2100 (MCAF Headquarters) and Building 2106 (BEQ).

(b) On Bauer Road and Cunningham Road

(c) In any area next to aircraft hangars 2101, 2102, 2103, 2104, and 2105.

(d) In any area which has been designated as a "No Parking" area and is so marked.

(e) In other areas as specified in reference (a).

(3) Trailers, travel trailers and camper trailers will not be parked aboard MCAF without the permission of the Commanding Officer, MCAF.

d. Operators of any motor vehicle will comply with the provisions of reference (a).

e. Traffic Mishaps

(1) Drivers of vehicles involved in any motor vehicle mishap will comply with the provisions of reference (a).

(2) In the event of a motor vehicle mishap, PMO will be notified immediately.

3. Enforcement of Traffic Regulations

a. As specified by reference (a), the enforcement of traffic regulations is primarily the responsibility of the military police; however, due to the peculiarities of the security requirements aboard MCAF, HMX-1 security personnel will assist in the enforcement of traffic regulations. This authorization is limited to the area along Rowell Road from the MCAF Headquarters building to the MCAF BOQ. DD Forms 1408 and 1805 (traffic citations for moving violations will be issued by military police personnel at the request of designated MCAF/HMX-1 security personnel.

b. Non-moving traffic citations will be issued by MCAF Logistics personnel, who will be designated by the MCAF Logistics Officer. Owners of vehicles in various stages of repair or missing major components (engines, transmissions, wheels/tires, etc) will be notified to relocate their vehicles to the Auto Hobby Shop or be subject to NJP proceedings for failure to comply with the provisions of this Order.

ENCLOSURE (1)

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

1. General. Vehicle registration procedures will be in accordance with reference (b) and as set forth in this Order. All personnel in the categories listed below are required to register their vehicles with the MCAF/HMX-1 Security Office:

a. Active duty military personnel permanently assigned to HqSqdn, MCAF.

b. Active duty military personnel permanently assigned to HMX-1.

c. Civilian employees of any activity aboard MCAF to include Navy Supply.

d. Officers residing in Building 2108 (MCAF, BOQ).

2. Procedure

a. Vehicle registration may be accomplished at PMO between 0800 and 1700 on weekdays, excluding holidays.

b. Vehicles to be registered must possess a valid military installation decal issued by MCCDC PMO as required by reference (b). Exceptions to situations not covered by the provisions of the above will be referred to the Security Officer, HMX-1 for determination.

c. The owner will present evidence of vehicle ownership and a certificate of state registration required by the state in which the vehicle is registered.

d. The vehicle must have a valid vehicle safety inspection

3. Registration Form. An OPNAV 5560/1 Non-Government Vehicle Registration Form will be utilized for registering vehicles.

4. Registration Decal. The MCAF decal will be a 3" x 2" red rectangle with naval aviators insignia in gold with a white MCAF overprint. The decal number will be in the upper top center.

5. Standard Placement. The MCAF vehicle decal will be attached to the immediate right or left of the valid installation decal on the bumper or windshield.

6. Effective Period of Registration. Permanent registration will be effective for the period that the individual is assigned to Headquarters Squadron, HMX-1, and the MCAF BOQ. Vehicles registered for 45 days or less will be issued a temporary pass by HMX-1 Security.

ENCLOSURE (2)

7. Surrender of Decal

a. Authorization to possess the MCAF decal automatically expires upon transfer, discharge, or upon sale, transfer of title or other disposal of the vehicle.

b. The responsibility for compliance with the provisions of this Order rests with the person to whom the decal is issued. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action or other action deemed appropriate.

8. Notification of Change. Appropriate notification will be made to PMO under the following circumstances:

a. Upon transfer or discharge of active duty military personnel, civilian employees, and technical representatives.

b. Upon sale or other disposal of a registered vehicle.

c. When license plates are changed.

d. When decals have been destroyed, mutilated, lost, stolen, or worn out.

e. When driving privileges aboard MCCDC have been suspended or revoked.

9. Implied Consent

a. By having a MCAF decal affixed to a privately owned vehicle, the owner certifies that no one other than a bonafide dependent or other person eligible for a decal will operate the automobile aboard Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico or attempt to use the vehicle to gain access to MCAF.

b. Random checks of vehicle ownership will be conducted at the MCAF gate. The number of vehicles to be inspected and the dates will be specified in writing by the Commanding Officer, MCAF.

c. Random searches will be conducted in accordance with references (b) and (c).
