

COMMANDING OFFICER'S
SAFETY POLICY

Safety requires commitment of all personnel to be truly successful. SAFETY MUST NOT, AND WILL NOT, BE SACRIFICED FOR EXPEDIENCY OR CONVENIENCE. Every Marine, Sailor or Civilian employee assigned to Marine Corps Air Facility, Quantico is empowered with resolving safety issues. There will be no reprisals when safety concerns are brought to the attention of this command. We must all adhere to the following principles that are at the core of our commitment to safety:

- Seek improvement in everything you do
- Identify hazards and take actions to correct them, regardless if on duty or off
- Use Operational Risk Management to weigh decisions
- Strictly adhere to published standards; use sound professional judgment
- Be responsible and accountable for your actions
- Break the chain of events that lead up to an accident BEFORE the accident occurs
- Aggressively challenge the actions of others if unsafe conditions become apparent
- Practice Motor Vehicle Safety as a daily part of your routine
- Remain consistent and unrelenting in not accepting the operation of down or marginal systems
- You are a United States Marine. Live, work and fly to that standard.
